Noticia 1 - Donación a comunidad de Antímano

The Vice minister of External Relation for Asia, Middle East and Australia, William Izarra; the Ambassador of India, Deepak Bhojwani and his wife, officers of the Embassy, the President of the Indian Association in Venezuela, Abu Abraham, members of the Association and Gustavo Rosario, Director of Citizen management of the Caracas Mayor's Office, among other personalities, were in charge of the handing over the donation to the community El Carmen, La Batea, La Sequia y las Morochas of Antimano.

The Ambassador of India, Deepak Bhojwani, said that " We here to support, not only to give a donation, that will be a drop of water in the ocean of effort that the Venezuelan Government has been doing with the Missions" Added that the donation was done mainly by the industrialist of the pharmaceutical sector of his country.

In this sense, he remarked the importance of the Pharmaceutical Industry in India and Venezuela , where he explained that 10 companies are acting not only to market their production, but to set up plants.
